Registration Information

Resident Camper

Resident campers live on campus and all meals are provided. The comprehensive resident camper fee includes a camp t-shirt.

Day Camper

Day campers have the same schedule as resident campers. Lunch and supper meals are included. The day camper fee includes a camp t-shirt.

Shooting Camp (SC)

This day camp is specifically designed to improve a camper's shooting technique. Drills, video, and repetition are used to advance the camper's knowledge of their shot and scoring opportunities. Registration is at 8:45.

Varsity Camp

The varsity camp is for players (grades 9-12) who anticipate participating with their varsity program in the coming year.

Registration

Refund Policy

All cancellations, for any reason, will be assessed a minimum \$50 processing fee. If the cancellation is made within two weeks of camp, except for injury, the cancellation fee is \$100. A camper departing camp early due to an injury will receive a prorated refund minus the \$50 fee. No refunds are given for no-shows, homesickness or campers sent home for disciplinary reasons.



Camp Philosophy

The "Gustie" Basketball and Leadership Camp is designed to help each player, from the highly skilled to those who are just beginning. With the aid of an experienced staff, the camp program is carefully designed to develop individual skills, stimulate personal goals and give each participant a unique and meaningful experience.

The ultimate aim of the camp is to develop a well-rounded basketball player emphasizing discipline, floor presence, and team concepts. Leadership and team building skills are integrated into league play and discussed in off-court sessions. Each player receives individual attention designed to help correct and improve areas of weakness or inexperience.

Fundamentals are taught daily and reinforced in league play. In order to maximize the experience for each player teams are kept small and playing time is equal.

Camp Director



Mark Hanson is the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Hanson has accumulated a 471-218 (.683) record, winning six MIAC Championships and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has guided Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 times and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship seven times. His

teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. In 2003 the Gusties reached the Final Four for the first time in school history and placed second in the nation.

The remaining camp staff is made up of Gustavus staff members, high school and college coaches as well as qualified college players. Our talented staff is one of the reasons our camp is so popular.
